NORFOLK - Carlos Enrique Agnese of Norfolk, Va., died on Monday, Nov. 14, due to complications from a car accident while on a hunting trip in Colorado. He was 80 years old.

Born to Jose and Lucia Agnese on April 4, 1931, Carlos was raised and educated in the town of Villa Constitucion, Santa Fe, Argentina. In 1955, sponsored by the Rotary Club, he traveled to Norfolk to continue his education and pursue a new life. After earning an engineering degree from Virginia Tech, he worked as an apprentice at NORSHIPCO and retired after more than four decades as executive vice president. In 1961, he married Edwina Gray Marlowe of Norfolk.

Carlos is survived by his partner Susan Roady; children Braulio and Lydia Agnese; sister Alicia Ripa; nephews Mario Ripa and Jorge Agnese; and numerous cousins, nephews, and nieces.
